- College Transcripts If you are a *new first-time* student to San Jacinto College you will need to hand deliver an official sealed transcript (must be issued within the last 60 days) OR request your former college/university to send an official sealed transcript directly to Admissions. All courses completed outside the San Jacinto College District must be evaluated by Admissions. Transcripts should be requested as soon as possible; do not wait until the application period beginning dates to request transcripts.

• Official Transcripts for Application:

College transcripts – Applicants must submit official transcripts from <u>all</u> colleges/universities attended, including San Jacinto College, with your application to the Radiography Program. Applicants will need to request official transcripts be sent to themselves, then save or scan to PDF to upload to the online application. Un-official transcripts printed from college websites will not be accepted. **Please order transcripts or scan to request preside by the student in time to submit with application by due deta**
