Meeting Time: shown in military time. Ex: 13:20 is 1:20PM

POT: Part of term. Indicates the length and start date of the course.

1M, 1E, 1T are all 16 week courses

12M, 12T are 12 week courses that start during the 4th week of the regular semester

8A is an 8-week course that begins on the first day of the semester and ends mid-term

8B is an 8-week course that begins mid-semester and ends with the regular term

4A, 4B, 4C, 4D are four week courses

POT Start Date: First day of the course

POT End Date: Last day of the course

Instructor: instructor assigned to teach the course

Room No.: Location of the course. Room number begin by noting the building number and then the classroom number.

Ex: N2.123 would be Building 2 on the North campus, room 123.

Reg. Date: the date that class was added to the student's schedule. It may helpful to sort this column from Newest to Oldest to see the most recent changes. Please note that this will not show courses that have been dropped.

Grade: grades will be posted in this column. You may also see drop codes here.

Student Type: current grade level in high school

H-Freshmen

P-Sophomore

J-Junior

S-Senior

Amt Due: balance due for book fees, library fees, traffic violations. A high balance indicates the discount has not been applied due to outstanding fees.

Memo Balance- a negative balance in this column indicates an active payment plan

Overall_INST_EARNED_HRS-overall semester credit hours earned

Overall GPA: cumulative GPA

Academic Standing: current academic status

Good standing: making satisfactory progress

Academic Warning: GPA below 2.0

Academic Probation: GPA below 2.0 for two semester

Academic Suspension: GPA below 2.0 for three or more semester. Cannot attend classes the following semester. Must lay out one semester or submit an academic appeal to EPCC to return immediately.
